Fraud Control Program

Miami-Dade Housing Agency (MDHA) is committed to eliminating fraudulent activity, program abuses or violations through the MDHA Fraud Control Program. The program enables MDHA, in coordination with law enforcement and other governmental agencies, to identify and prevent program abuse, sanction offenders who take advantage of the system, and recover funds when appropriate.

The MDHA Fraud Hotline is available specifically to receive calls regarding allegations of suspected fraud or wrongdoing by MDHA residents, employees, or entities doing business under MDHA authorization. Those found guilty of fraud will be subject to removal from respective programs as well as adjudicated any other fines and sentences that may be incurred.

Miami-Dade County mandates all employees, business owners, landlords and residents to comply with local codes, ordinances, and regulations. The County wants to know if any employees, business owners, and/or entities are failing to fulfill their obligations under MDHA's programs.
